SEALING OF RECORD/EXPUNGEMENT INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS AFTER NOT GUILTY FINDING OR DISMISSAL

A Defendant, by law pursuant to Ohio Rev. Code 2953.32, may make an application for the Sealing of Record/Expungement of official records after a Not Guilty finding or dismissal of proceedings in the case.

- 1. You will need to acquire the Application for Order Sealing Record After Not Guilty Finding or Dismissal and Expungement packet from the Euclid Municipal Court, Clerk of Courts Department located at 555 East 222nd Street, Euclid, Ohio 44123, request by e-mail at info@euclidmunicourt.com, or call (216)289-2888 if you are unable to obtain the application in person in order to receive further instructions.
- 2. You must pay a filing fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) to file an Application for Order Sealing Record After Not Guilty Finding or Dismissal. This payment should be made to the Euclid Municipal Court, Clerk of Courts Department in person or over the phone at the time of filing. If paying in person with cash, it must be the exact amount. Other forms of payment accepted include: Credit Card, Money Order or Check.
- 3. If unable to pay the fifty dollar (\$50.00) filing fee you can inquire about the Application to Proceed without Payment of Fees and Affidavit. Once you submit your application, it will be reviewed and a decision will be sent to you via USPS mail indicating if you can proceed without payment or if you need to contact the Euclid Municipal Court, Clerk's Office to make payment.
- 4. After you have submitted your Application for Order Sealing Record after Not Guilty Finding or Dismissal and your filing fee, you must fill out the Expungement Investigation Interview forms provided in your packet. These forms must be completed in their entirety and submitted to the Euclid Municipal Court, Probation Department. You can submit your Expungement Investigation Interview forms with all of your paperwork to the Clerk of Courts Office, return it by mail to the Euclid Probation Department Attention: Chief P.O. India George, at 555 East 222nd Street, Euclid, Ohio 44123 or submit via e-mail to i.george@euclidmunicourt.com within thirty (30) days of filing the application. If you need assistance with the Expungement Investigation Interview forms, please contact Chief Probation Officer India George at (216)289-8296.
- 5. After all forms are submitted, you will be contacted by the Euclid Police Department once your background check is complete, to conduct your phone interview and receive a reminder of your scheduled court date for sealing. You will receive a formal summons in the mail with your scheduled hearing date. The entire process may take up to 90 days from the date of filing.

DISCLAIMER

When a court orders a record sealed, it is effective on the date of the order to seal the official record and the record of the arresting agency and jail, if applicable. While a case is pending and even after the conviction or dismissal, the case is a public record. While a public record, individuals and private businesses may download information from court, police or jail files. The court order to seal does not undo such dissemination nor does it apply to private individuals or businesses that may have downloaded your case information before the sealing.

Therefore, be advised, that private individuals or businesses may still have your case information even after your official record is sealed. If you become aware of such information, it is your responsibility to notify the holder of the information of the existence of the order to seal the record and request that they comply with the spirit of the sealing law and delete their records. However, you should be aware that, under current law, they are not required to do so.
